Did you know that government limits competition for certain contracts to businesses in historically underutilized business zones (HUBZones)? It also gives preferential consideration to those businesses in full and open competition. Joining the HUBZone program makes your business eligible to compete for the program's set-aside contracts. Join us as the US Small Business Administration explains the process becoming certified as a HUBZone and how to go after federal contracts.
